The enigmatic, rather shy Peter Weygandt started his importing firm in 1987. In Issue 144, he was named as one of my "Wine Personalities of the Year." Tiny production and honest, unmanipulated wines are his strengths. While many of the producers he now represents (120 different ones) are little-known names, the quality is always impressive.
