2015 Domaine du Vissoux Beaujolais Cuvee Traditionelle- 88pts

The 2015 Beaujolais Cuvee Traditionelle has more freshness on the nose compared to the Pierre Chermette: Morello cherries tangy with crushed strawberry and a hint of rose petal. The palate is balanced with crushed strawberry and cassis, quite a structured Beaujolais with commendable persistence on the finish. Enjoy this "busty" Beaujolais over 4-5 years.

2015 Domaine du Vissoux Beaujolais Pierre Chermette- 86pts

The 2015 Beaujolais Pierre Chermette (labelled as "Les Griottes" domestically) has a simple but pure and quite intense dark cherry scented-bouquet. The palate is sweet and rounded, perhaps missing some of the freshness of its peers, fully bodied and assertive towards the heady finish. My advice is to drink this slightly chilled.

2015 Domaine du Vissoux Brouilly Pierreux- 89pts

The 2015 Brouilly Pierreux has a slightly smudged mulberry and dark cherry-scented bouquet that would benefit from a little more freshness. The palate is medium-bodied with sweet redcurrant and strawberry fruit, mixed with soy and a pinch of sea salt on the finish. This is a well crafted and harmonious Brouilly that would benefit from a year in bottle.
